2020 Census



The Census Bureau doesn't send unsolicited emails for your participation in the 2020 Census, unless you have signed up to receive them. The Census Bureau will never ask for your information via email. The Census Bureau will never ask for your Social Security number, your bank account or credit card numbers or anything on behalf of a political party.
